TITLE 1—SCHOOL PARENT COMPACT

In an ongoing effort to increase the success of students, the Laclede County R-1 School establishes this parent compact as a partnership between parents, community and staff. This compact will serve as a guideline for establishment, review, participation, and communication of the Title 1 program. This compact is designed to build and develop a partnership between parents and the school. This compact is designed through the input of the Title 1 committee, which is composed of parents, teachers, administrators and staff. It will be reviewed each year. This compact will be sent home with all Title 1 students on an annual basis.

In an effort to provide high quality curriculum and instruction the activities will include, but are not limited to:

- The school will establish a District-wide Title 1 committee composed of staff, parents and community. This committee will be responsible for the approval of the LEA plan, review of student data, plan or revise effective parent involvement, and conduct an annual review of the program.
- The school will provide assistance to participating parents by providing a parent resource library, hold parent-teacher conferences, and allow parents the opportunity to volunteer in the classroom.
- The school district will provide quarterly student achievement reports for all students in the Title 1 program.

In order to educate school personnel:

- The Title 1 committee will provide access to the Program Review and minutes of all meetings.
- Title 1 teachers will meet regularly with classroom teachers to review grade-level curriculum
- Title 1 committee members will serve on the district SIT team

Activities suggested for Parental Support of the Title 1 program include:

- Participation in parent/teacher conferences
- Participation in the classroom through a school-wide parent volunteer program
- Provide at home intervention resources to parents
- Attend Title 1 meetings when possible
- Establish contact with the Title 1 teacher whenever possible
- Communication through facebook page, school website and electronic newsletter

The district will ensure that information related to school and parent programs, meetings and other activities is sent to the homes of Title 1 children in the family's primary language by:

• Upon enrollment in school, each family will be surveyed as to the student's primary language spoken at home and vital information in that language will be provided.
